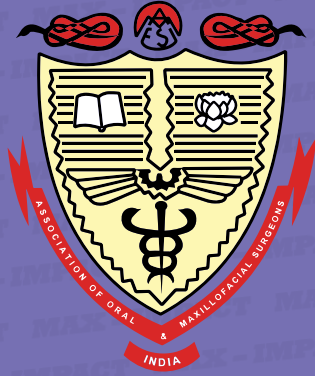

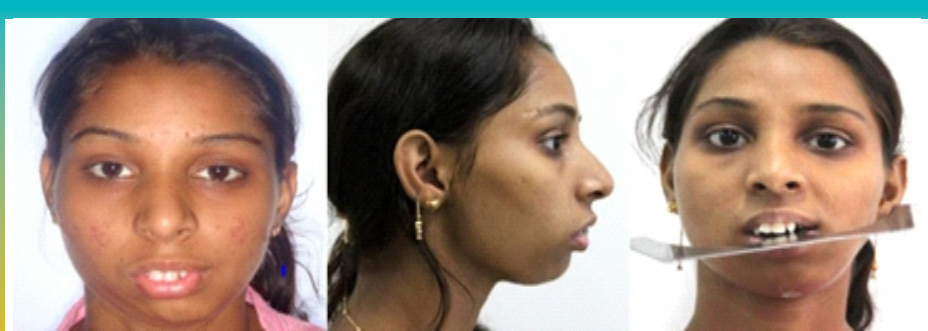

SURGICAL UPDATE

Celebrating the Women Surgeons in Delhi NCR region

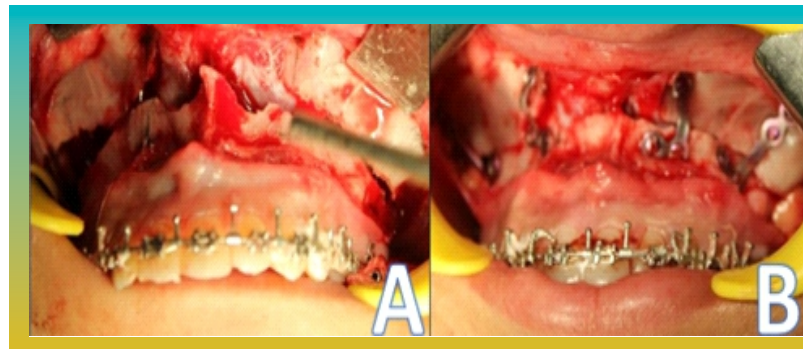

Management of Facial Asymmetry secondary to TMJ ankylosis

Achieving facial symmetry in a maxillomandibular deformity is a challenging process after completion of growth. This case report aims to provide the outcome of concomitant mandibular distraction with orthognathic surgery in a 20 year old female with facial dysmorphism secondary to TMJ Ankylosis. The patient had been operated for TMJ Ankylosis on left side 5 years back. Extra-oral examination revealed facial asymmetry with chin deviation towards left side, incompetent lips and increased maxillary incisal display. Intra orally, Angles class II Div1 malocclusion was observed with canting of 5 mm. The surgical management included Lefort I osteotomy with differential superior repositioning followed by bilateral mandibular distractor placement with variable vectors to correct facial height and mandibular retrusion. The distraction was continued until upper and lower facial midline were coinciding with slight overcorrection to prevent relapse. A consolidation period of 6 months was allowed before removal of the distraction device. The patient underwent orthodontic treatment both pre and post-surgery for occlusal settlement. After completion of surgical process, there was a significant increase in the ramal height of the affected side with correction of the intercommisure plane and facial symmetry.

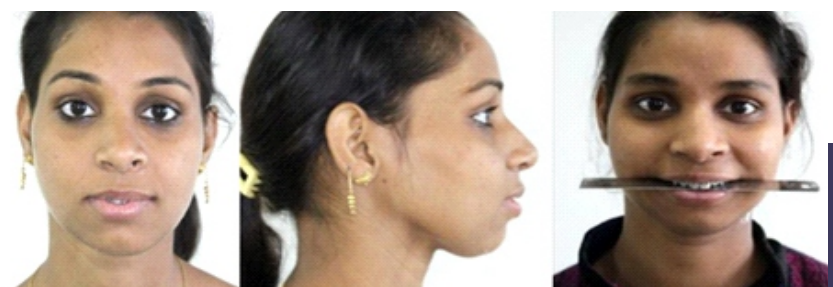


Preoperative facial profile of (20-year-old) female with facial asymmetry secondary to unilateral TMJ Ankylosis

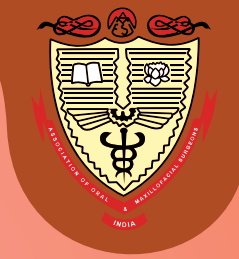
School of Dental Sciences, Sharda University – 13th February, 2023

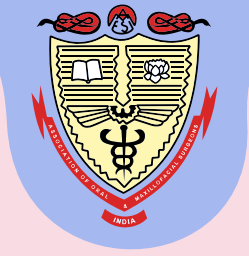

Looked at me, reassured!

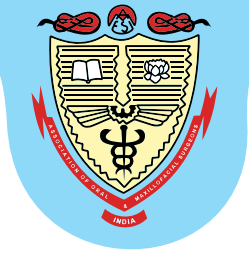
Joy filled my heart

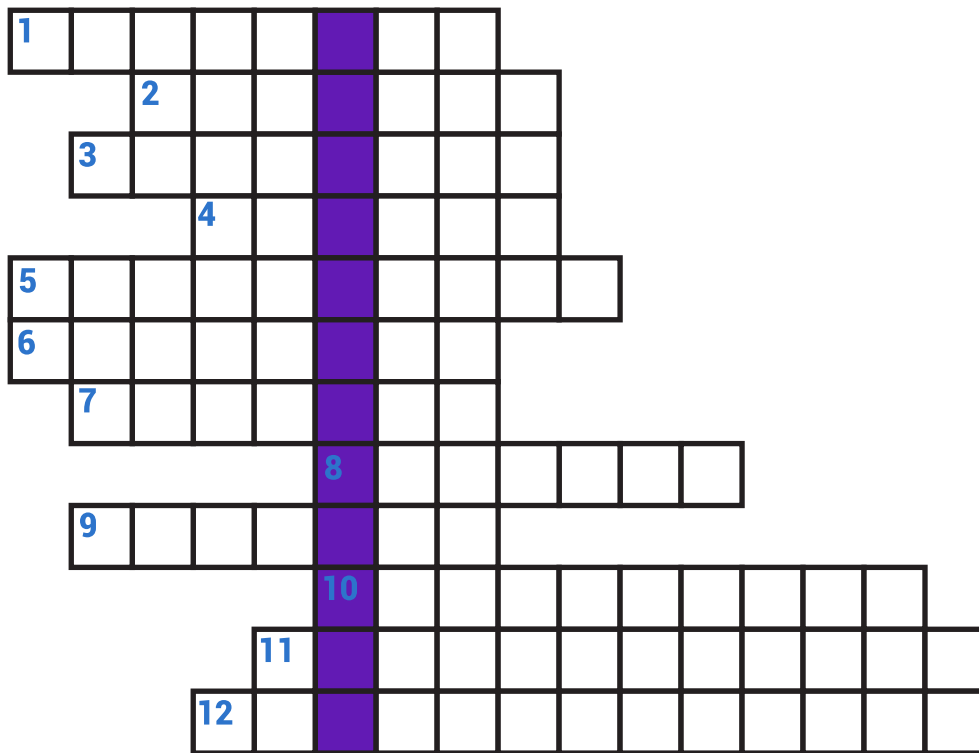
